Romvinza®	For treatment of adult patients with a rare form of aggressive tumor that can involve a joint or tendon		PA, SP
Vanrafia®	To reduce the buildup of protein in the urine in adult patients with a specific type of chronic kidney disease		PA, SP

Brilinta®	ticagrelor 90 mg tablet	For prevention of heart attack and stroke in adult patients with history of cardiovascular disease	
Impoyz®	clobetasol 0.025% cream	For topical treatment of adult patients with plaque psoriasis	
Purixan®	mercaptopurine suspension	For treatment of adult and pediatric patients with a specific type of cancer of the blood	
Ridaura®	auranofin	For treatment of adult patients with rheumatoid arthritis	
Xarelto®	rivaroxaban 2.5 mg tablet	To treat and prevent blood clots in adult and pediatric patients
